<div>Attacking</div> <div><div>Support</div><div>To give the player in possession as many options as possible team-mates move into different posi-tions to receive the ball. This could be to the side / behind / in front of the ball.</div><div></div></div> <div><div>Improvisation</div><div>Players need to become creative to get past an organised defence e.g. one-twos, fake passes, outwit defenders with the ball</div><div></div></div>
